The HELCOM-VASAB MSP Working Group Work Plan 2017-2019 has been agreed by the 74th VASAB CSPD/BSR and HELCOM 38-2017. Minor changes to the original version were agreed by HELCOM 38 in item 3.3, namely Germany confirmed to contribute to the activity on green infrastructure and addition in footnote "Taking into account MPAs protection targets and management plans."
