<u>«International comparisons of statistical indicators of Russia and the EU:</u> achievements, challenges and solutions"

Goal – consolidate the efforts of the countries participating in comparisons and explore effective instruments for constructing regular comparisons of statistical data, introducing EU statistical indicators in the Russian practice, popularization of statistics.

Objectives:

Discuss challenges, appearing during the collaborative calculations of indexes, indicators, comparisons of statistical data; find out general solutions, the possibility of creating "compendium" and/or "glossarium" to compare indicators of Eurostat and Rosstat.

Directions for discussion (speakers and opponents)

- Borders for possible comparison. Methodic problems of statistical systems. Spatial division – NUTs and regions in Russia. Administrative-geographical boundaries of statistical objects. Conceptual framework – possibilities to create glossarium? Quality of life index.
- Cross-border cooperation and interchange of data. Interregional comparisons of cross-border regions of Russia, Finland, Poland and other countries in cooperation projects of Rosstat regional offices and international statistical offices and also in cooperation projects between Russian and EU regions.
- Cooperation between cities and opportunities to share experiences and comparisons. Comparative characteristic of European cities – regular city statistics URBAN AUDIT, ESPON TeMo, regional statistics of the Baltic sea, Barents sea. Publications, comparative tables on the web-site and organization of presentations.
- Successful examples of comparisons in cooperation projects and research. Interstate Statistical Committee of the Commonwealth of Independent States experience on constructing comparative characteristics. Multinational comparisons of statistical data in statistical commissions of UN, EU. Experience of using common indicators in cooperation projects of EU and Russian regions.
