# Background

The Tenth Meeting of the joint HELCOM-VASAB Maritime Spatial Planning Working Group (HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 10-2015) will be held at the Hotel Scandic Crown (Polhemsplatsen 3) in Gothenburg, Sweden, on 29-30 January 2015 upon invitation by the Swedish Agency for Marine and Water Management (SwAM). The Meeting will be opened on Thursday, 29 January at 10:00 and is expected to terminate no later than at 14:30 the following day.

The Meeting will be co-chaired by Ms. Anita Mäkinen, Finland, and Mr. Andrzej Cieślak, Poland, Co-chairs of the Working Group.

The focus of the Meeting will be on the Guidelines on application of the ecosystem approach, transboundary consultations and cooperation and public participation in MSP to be developed as agreed within the <u>Regional</u> <u>Baltic Maritime Spatial Planning Roadmap 2013-2020</u>. The Guidelines are to be drafted and adopted by 2015 and applied by 2018.

As agreed by HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 6-2013 (paragraph 1.2), Contracting Parties/Member Countries as well as Observers are requested to submit substantial documents requiring a decision or action to the Secretariats (<u>laura.meski@helcom.fi</u> and <u>info@vasab.org</u>) at the latest four weeks in advance of the meeting. However, due to the holiday season the deadline will be postponed with one week until <u>8 January 2015</u>. Information documents should be submitted at the latest two weeks in advance of the meeting i.e. <u>by 15 January 2015</u>. The handling of documents, which are submitted later than given deadlines, will be considered by the Co-Chairs together with the Secretariats.

The Meeting is invited to <u>take note</u> of information on activities related to the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR) and Horizontal Action (HA) Spatial Planning for which the HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG acts as the Steering Committee concerning the MSP part and to <u>consider</u> the update and review of the current chapter on HA Spatial Planning including objectives, targets and indicators.
