Provisional Annotated Agenda

The Ninth Meeting of the Joint HELCOM-VASAB Maritime Spatial Planning Working Group (HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 9-2014) will be held at the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Regional Development of Latvia (Peldu street 25) in Riga, Latvia, on 16 June 2014. The Meeting will be opened on Monday, 16 June at 09:00 hrs and is expected to terminate no later than 18:00 hrs the same day.

The Meeting will be co-chaired by the Working Group Co-Chairs Ms. Anita Mäkinen, Finland, and Mr. Andrzej Cieślak, Poland.

The focus of the Meeting will be on the input of the WG to the VASAB Ministerial Conference and on data needs for MSP. The Contracting Parties/Member States are invited to consider inviting relevant data experts, also with connections to other data developments on the Baltic Sea and EU level, to attend the meeting. In order to save time and enable discussion on these issues, other issues and documents are foreseen to be introduced only in brief.

As agreed by HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 6-2013 (paragraph 1.2), substantial documents requiring a decision or action should be submitted to the Secretariats (laura.meski@helcom.fi and info@vasab.org) at the latest four weeks in advance of the meeting, i.e. by 19 May 2014 and information documents should be submitted at the latest two weeks in advance of the meeting i.e. by 2 June 2014. The handling of documents, which are submitted later than given deadlines, will be considered by the Co-Chairs together with the Secretariats.

Agenda Item 1 Adoption of the Agenda

The Provisional Agenda (document 1-1) and the Provisional Annotated Agenda (document 1-2) has been prepared on the basis of the Minutes of the Eighth Meeting of the HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG as well as consultations between the Chairs of the HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG and the HELCOM and VASAB Secretariats.

Agenda Item 2 Information on MSP developments and regional coordination

HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG

MSP developments

The European Commission is invited to inform the Meeting on the adoption of the Directive on MSP (17 April 2014) and on the progress with development of the EU implementation Guidelines.

The Meeting is invited to <u>take note</u> of the overview on national MSP developments, to be submitted at a later stage. The overview, based on information previously reported by the Contracting Parties/Member Countries, will be circulated for updating in advance of the Meeting as decided at HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 4/2012 (paragraph 2.6). In addition, Contracting Parties/Member Countries are invited to briefly inform of any major national MSP developments during the Meeting.

The Meeting is invited to <u>discuss</u> and <u>agree</u> on the outline of the updated country fiches (files), prepared by the PartiSEApate project, to be submitted at a later stage, and <u>consider</u> their alignment with the overview table on MSP developments (cf. previous paragraph). The final country fiches will be published on the HELCOM and VASAB web pages as agreed by HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 8-2014 (cf.paragraph 3.17).

The Meeting is invited to take note of information by the Secretariats on activities related to the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR) and Horizontal Action (HA) Spatial Planning for which the HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG acts as the Steering Committee, including the matters concerning EUSBSR Seed Money Facility activities and the HA Spatial Planning Flagship project PartiSEApate.

Agenda Item 4 Data needs for MSP

HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 8-2014 recognized the need to work further on MSP data according to the new HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG Work Plan 2014-2016. The Meeting is invited to <u>consider</u> a proposal for establishing regional cooperation on MSP data as part of the HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG, to be submitted at a later stage by Germany, and <u>decide</u> on the way forward.

Agenda Item 5 Practical application of the Ecosystem Approach in MSP

HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 8-2014 appreciated the renewed offer by Finland to have the lead for finalizing the document on the understanding of the ecosystem approach and the offer by the European Commission, Germany and Sweden to provide further input. The Meeting is invited to <u>finalize</u> the document to be submitted at a later stage by Finland.
