
PLAN BOTHNIA MARE/2009/16 Co-financed under European Integrated Maritime Policy



PLAN BOTHNIA and Bothnian Sea

- Two supporting 18 mth "preparatory actions" calls launched by DG MARE in 2009
 - Baltic –PLAN BOTHNIA (Dec 2010-)
 - North Sea -MASPNOSE (Dec 2010-)
- PLAN BOTHNIA: Bothnian Sea area between Finland and Sweden
- Good history of subregional cooperation
- Both sides of the border similar

- Facilitate and Involve regional and national actors
 - Five dedicated meetings
- Phase I: Background information and assessment
 - Assessment document and GIS datasets (Spring-Autumn 2011)
- Phase II: Spatial Plan
 - -Test drafting of a MSP Plan based on I (winter 2011-2012)



Other Components

- International evaluation
 - In the end (Spring 2012)
- Monitoring and evaluation (HELCOM)
 - minor report by spring 2012
- 2 Stakeholder events (VASAB)
 - 1st October/November 2011?
 - 2nd end of May 2012 (present results)
