Background

According to the [Regional Baltic Marine Spatial Planning Roadmap 2013-2020](#) (point 4.1) and the [HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG Work Plan 2014-2016](#) the HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG is to identify competent contact points for MSP for the purpose of transboundary consultation and joint planning. The HELCOM and VASAB Secretariats are to keep the list updated.

HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 10-2015 (29-30 January 2015) decided that the information on the contact points will be included in the [country fiches](#) and HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG 11-2015 (30 September-1 October 2015) decided to also keep a separate list in parallel to the information in the country fiches as the information is thus more easily accessed and more easily referred to.
