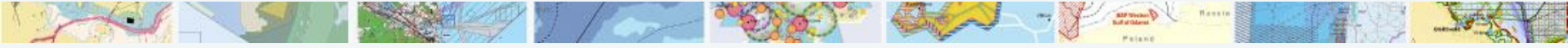

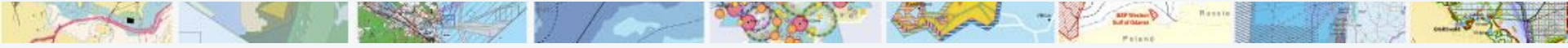

- It was agreed that the new & updated version of the VASAB compendium (dated 2009) shall be an online-publication sub-divided by countries (i.e. possible to open separate country chapters only), in order to facilitate regular updating of information.
- It was suggested that a print version should provide a short (one pg long) „fact sheet“ about MSP structures in each country. The group suggested that a first print version would be made available in time for the Helcom Ministerial Meeting to be held on 3rd October 2013.



The VASAB secretariat has selected Mr. Axel Wenblad as the external consultant, who will be in charge of

- a) **Concept** for a transnational institutional and governance model on transnational coordination, agreements and data exchange in MSP (1st draft: „the best possible approach for the BSR“; 2nd draft: „outcome of the consultation process“) and
 - b) **Recommendations** for transnational MSP (a policy document, based on the *Minimum requirements*, *VISION 2030*, *BaltSeaPlan Data Recommendations* and *PartiSEApate project outcomes*)
- *It was suggested that the MSP Expert Group shall jointly draft an “input paper” to be provided for the Helcom Ministerial Conference during the next MSP Expert Group meeting*
