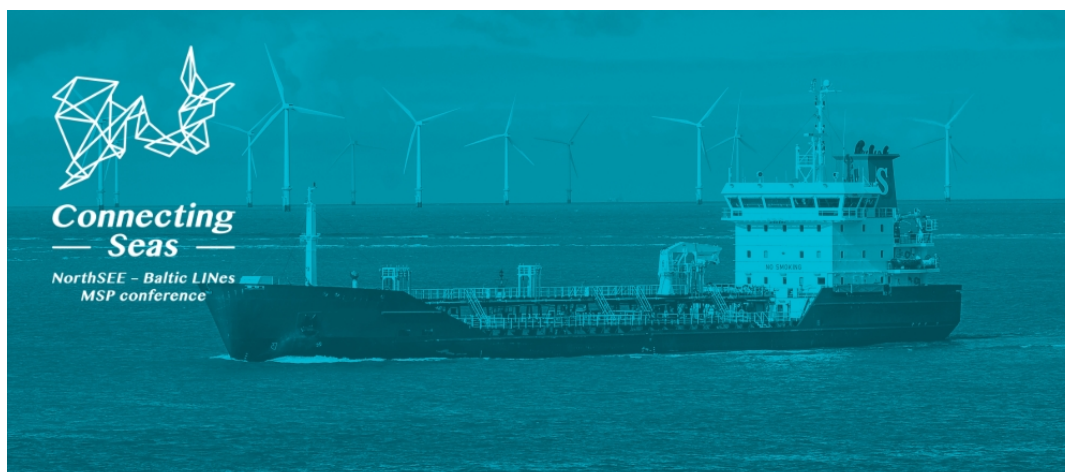
Dear VASAB Friends,

GUIDELINES FOR MSP OUTPUT DATA INFRASTRUCTURE

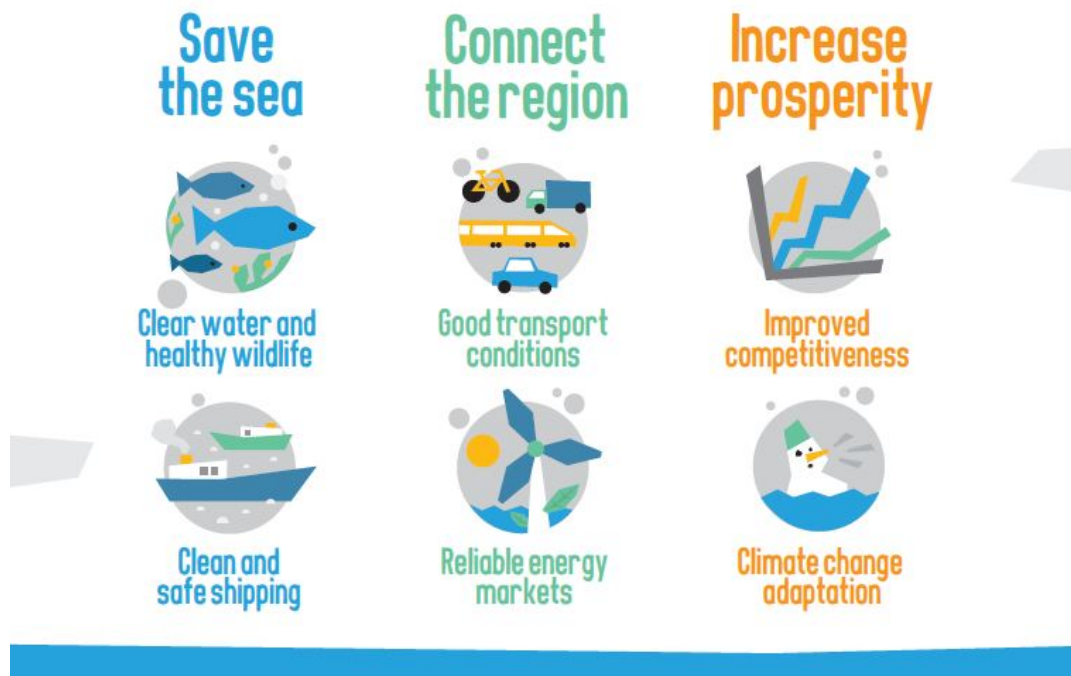
After intensive and fruitful collaboration BSR countries agreed on coherent approach for MSP output data structure.

The BSR MSP Data Expert subgroup had elaborated "The Guidelines on transboundary MSP output data structure" that were agreed by the joint HELCOM-VASAB MSP Working Group in November 2018. [Download the guidelines HERE.](#)

NEW ESPON PROJECT - TERRITORIAL SCENARIOS FOR THE BSR

Initiated by VASAB countries, project BT2050 started in November 2018 and will last until October 2019. The objective is to develop territorial scenarios for the BSR to contribute to cooperation between BSR countries on territorial development, increase evidence based on the territorial dimension of the EU Strategy for the BSR, as well as be beneficial to EU Member States' policy making.
