#### Background

The HELCOM-VASAB MSP Working Group Work Plan 2017-2019 has been agreed by the 74th VASAB CSPD/BSR and HELCOM 38-2017. As the Work Plan is coming to its end, the HELCOM and VASAB Secretariats made a draft evaluation of its implementation. The document is intended to support the Working Group to define the next Work Plan for the period 2020 – 2021.

The basis material to prepare this document is the <u>Work Plan 2017-2019</u>. Two columns (Status of implementation and proposed future action) were added to reflect the state of implementation of individual actions and propose future actions for the HELCOM-VASAB MSP WG.
