- **confronts conflicts** in marine and coastal space ecology and space use and **pursues mediation**,
- strives for comprehensively **sustainable** (considering social, economical and environmental aspects) **use and managament** of space,
- efficiently makes use of all knowledge and resources available in the governable entity at all levels,
- responsibly **allocates governance power** to governors and the governed alike,
- accounts for governance errors by designing a process that allows learning and improvement.



- Allow planning realistic timelines,
- Ensure measurability and trackability of processes from the outset.




Foundations and goals for MLG agenda
