During the last decade new challenges and trends have arisen at global and BSR level that has brought VASAB Committee on Spatial Planning and Development of the Baltic Sea Region to a decision to update the Long-Term Perspective for the Territorial Development of the BSR (LTP).

Updated LTP will support different stakeholders in the BSR countries in policy making to cope with challenges with a trans-national relevance for the sustainable territorial development, and to better anticipate and prepare for the future development paths towards territorial cohesion perspective of the BSR till 2040.

Particularly, it will propose necessary recommendations targeted for transnational and cross-border cooperation and synergies in such fields as:

- settlement development,
- accessibility to efficient transport and ICT,
- integrated energy production and supply,
- maritime spatial planning and management.

For the next two years LTP update will be steered by VASAB Committee and led by a partnership of **Spatial Foresight GmbH** and **Nordregio**, both together having a long experience in EU policies, territorial cooperation, visions and scenario development, development and implementation of strategies, a considerable focus on the Baltic Sea Region and a long track record of working together.

#### EUSBSR Policy Area Spatial Planning

With the approval by the European Commission on the 15 February 2021, the revision process of the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR) Action Plan has concluded and the implementation can accelerate. The New Action Plan will be more focused with **14 Policy areas** and 44 actions, support closer cooperation among stakeholders and support the achievement of targets set in the EU policies and UN Sustainable Development Agenda. In the new Action Plan, the former

Horizontal action Spatial Planning has been transformed into Policy area. **The Policy area Spatial Planning aims to increase territorial coherence in the BSR** by building a region that is better integrated and more coherent. Policy area is coordinated by VASAB and HELCOM.

#### Let's Continue to Communicate the EUSBSR

Let's Communicate! is a project funded by the INTERREG Baltic Sea Region Programme functions as the EUSBSR communication point. With the revised EUSBSR Action Plan coming into force, Let's Communicate project activities have been enlarged and prolonged by the end of 2021. project activities Current are with complemented the most essential tasks from three former Horizontal actions Capacity, Neighbours and Climate. The project serves as an interim solution for the Baltic Sea Strategy point that will be operational in 2022.

VASAB is a partner in the Let's Communicate consortium and is responsible for the development of the EUSBSR communication tool kit and newsletters for strategy's stakeholders.
