9th VASAB Ministerial Conference endorsed VASAB Vision 2040 and adopted Wismar Declaration 2023

On the 2nd of June 2023, the VASAB Ministers responsible for spatial planning and development in the Baltic Sea Region countries met for the 9th time to jointly discuss the complex challenges related to the geopolitical and energy policy changes in the Region and beyond.

The main focus of the **VASAB Ministerial Conference** was the endorsement of the **VASAB Vision 2040** and the **adoption of the Wismar Declaration 2023**, which underlined the commitment of participating countries to implement the VASAB Vision 2040.



VASAB Expert's Conference "Vibrant, Resilient, Well-connected - The Baltic Sea Region in 2040"

Conference was hosted on the 1st of June 2023 by Germany – VASAB Chairing country in period 2022-2023. The Conference was organised by the Federal Ministry for Housing, Urban Development and Building of Germany jointly with the Federal Institute for Research on Building, Urban Affairs and Spatial Development with support of the VASAB Secretariat.

The Conference brought together the experts and enthusiasts of spatial planning and regional development to celebrate the finalization of the VASAB Vision 2040 – the broad and extensive co-creation of joint views on how the Baltic Sea Region would develop and look like in 2040.
