








National Development Concept 2050 - role and its content





Intensity of urban sprawl








Local spatial development plan

arrangements and recommendations in the field of shaping and conducting spatial developmen policy


Model of functional and spatial structure

- Main goal: depening integration beetween strategic and spatial planning
- Part of the development strategy
- Obligatory at regional and local/supra-local level
- Consists of graphic (maps) and text
- Shows in simplified manner territorial dimension of current and future development
- Enhancing cooperation and engagement of stakeholders
